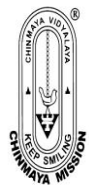

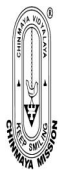

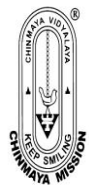

7. All the entries need to be submitted through the link which will be provided for uploading entries (via Whats App groups) and the file name of video, PPT, picture, etc. should specify SCHOOL CODE provided to schools after registration.
8. The participant should introduce himself/herself in the beginning of the video, using school code only.

Rules for Entry

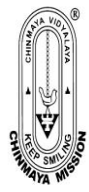
- 1. Only one participant per school is allowed.**

- 6. The participant should present their work with a suitable background.**

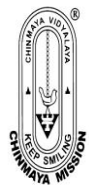

Rules For Entry

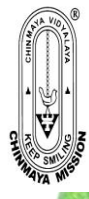
- 1 .Only one participant per school is allowed.

Rules For Entry

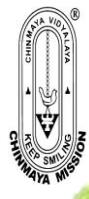
- 1. Only one participant per school is allowed.**
